It will soon be that time of year again! The remote and beautiful east side of Henry W. Coe State Park, including the Orestimba Wilderness, will be easily accessible again for one weekend this spring. The public will be allowed access through the park entrance gate at Bell's Station on Highway 152. The park entrance fee is \$20 per vehicle (one day), \$40 per vehicle (one night) or \$50 per vehicle (two nights). For more information, email:

One application per address. Carpooling is encouraged and all you need is one application. **Tickets will NOT be available at the entrance gate.**

Please make sure to include your **e-mail address CLEARLY PRINTED** on the application form.
