It will soon be that time of year again! The remote and beautiful east side of Henry W. Coe State Park, including the Orestimba Wilderness, will be easily accessible again for one weekend this spring. The public will be allowed access through the park entrance gate at Bell's Station on Highway 152. The park entrance fee is \$20 per vehicle (one day), \$40 per vehicle (two days) or \$50 per vehicle (backpackers ONLY for two days/two nights).
